The Practice **Exchange provides monthly** webinars for advocates on a variety of TAY-specific topics including housing, access to services, and transition-planning among many others. We also host a bi-monthly workshop hour which offers a more interactive. collaborative space to brainstorm and problem-solve around recurring issues in TAY advocacy work across the state.
